Target) English has become the lingua franca in today's global society. As globalization brings the world closer together, the need for global citizens to be able to communicate clearly in English is becoming more urgent. The aim of this course is to give students the opportunity to practice speaking English with an emphasis on correct pronunciation, rhythm and intonation. Listening to authentic texts by native speakers (through DVD and other media) will be an important part of the course. Practice in the four skills reading, writing, listening and speaking will be provided during class and through homework.

Outline) Students will be expected to take part in a number of role-plays and memorize short skits. Emphasis will be placed on pronunciation with natural rhythm and intonation. The following schedule is tentative and shows only general topics for each class. It may be modified depending on students' level and interest.

Goal)

1. Students will gain confidence in their understanding of English pronunciation (linking, assimilation, rhythm and intonation).
2. Students will improve their listening comprehension.

2. Listening activity and role play: Harry meets Ron
3. Listening to Narnia 1: Lucy meets Mr. Tumnus
4. Listening to Narnia 2: Lucy meets Mr. Tumnus (Part 2)
5. Listening to Narnia 3: Tea at Mr. Tumnus' House
6. Listening to Narnia 4: Back through the wardrobe
7. Listening to Narnia 5: Turkish delight
8. Listening to Narnia 6: Turkish delight (Part 2) and Lucy finds Edmund
9. Listening Test 1
10. Listening to Narnia 7: A Christmas Present
11. Listening to Narnia 8: Edmund at the Witch's House
12. Listening to Narnia 9: Aslan's Camp
13. Listening to Narnia 10: The Witch comes to Aslan's Camp

14. Presentations

15. Listening Test 2

16. Consolidation

Textbook) Handouts will be prepared by the instructor and no textbook is required.

Evaluation Criteria) Students will be assessed on class participation, homework, role plays, skits and written assignments. Tentative coursework evaluation: Attendance: 30%, Listening Tests: 40%, Written Assignment: 15%, Presentation 15%

Re-evaluation) Allowable if the student has attended more than 2/3 of the classes and has a score of 50% or higher.
